Program Details

The GIS Internship Program is organized around the project life cycle. Students work together to complete a GIS project that solves a specific problem. They collaborate with members of the City's GIS team to complete all phases of the project including initiation, planning, execution, and closure.

As students develop their team and complete the project, they work together to create GIS data, perform spatial analysis, and generate outputs. Using GIS as a problem solving and decision support tool is emphasized throughout. Collaboration and building a strong team are also emphasized. Coaching and feedback are key tools as the student team works closely with the City's GIS team.

Technical work is completed using the ArcGIS suite of software and emphasizes solution finding, strong data skills, and creative analytical techniques.
